Pulpwood Production¹ in the Lake States by County, 1988

ABSTRACT.—Lake States pulpwood production climbed to a record 8.14 million cords in 1988. Pulpwood production is shown by county and species group in Michigan, Minnesota, and Wisconsin.

KEY WORDS: Residue, Michigan, Minnesota, Wisconsin

Pulpwood production in the Lake States—Michigan, Minnesota, and Wisconsin—rose to a record 8.14 million cords in 1988 from 7.69 million cords in 1987. Wisconsin produced 3.09 million cords, Michigan produced 2.92 million cords, and Minnesota produced 2.13 million cords.

Ninety-two out of every 100 cords of pulpwood came from roundwood (including chips from roundwood); the remainder came from mill residue such as slabs, edgings, veneer cores, and chips from these materials. Production from softwood and hardwood residue by State was:

Major species harvested were aspen (3,681,000 cords), pine (993,600 cords), maple (868,400 cords), birch (585,900 cords), and balsam fir (359,600 cords).

Lake States loggers produced 655 thousand cords of whole tree chips (WTC), 8 percent more than in 1987 and 8 percent of total pulpwood output in 1988. Michigan was the major WTC producer with 534 thousand cords, followed by Minnesota with 77 thousand cords and Wisconsin with 44 thousand cords.

Counties cutting more than 130,000 cords each were Delta, Menominee, Dickinson, Marquette, and Ontonagon in Michigan; Koochiching, St. Louis, and Itasca in Minnesota; and Forest, Marinette, Oneida, Vilas, Bayfield, and Sawyer in Wisconsin. These 14 counties contributed two out of every five cords of pulpwood produced from roundwood in the Lake States in 1988.
