Pulpwood Production in the Lake States, 1995

ABSTRACT.—Pulpwood production in the Lake States decreased from 9.7 million cords in 1994 to 9.6 million in 1995. Michigan, Minnesota, and Wisconsin pulpwood production is shown by county and species group.

KEY WORDS: Residue, roundwood, whole tree chips, Minnesota, Michigan, Wisconsin.

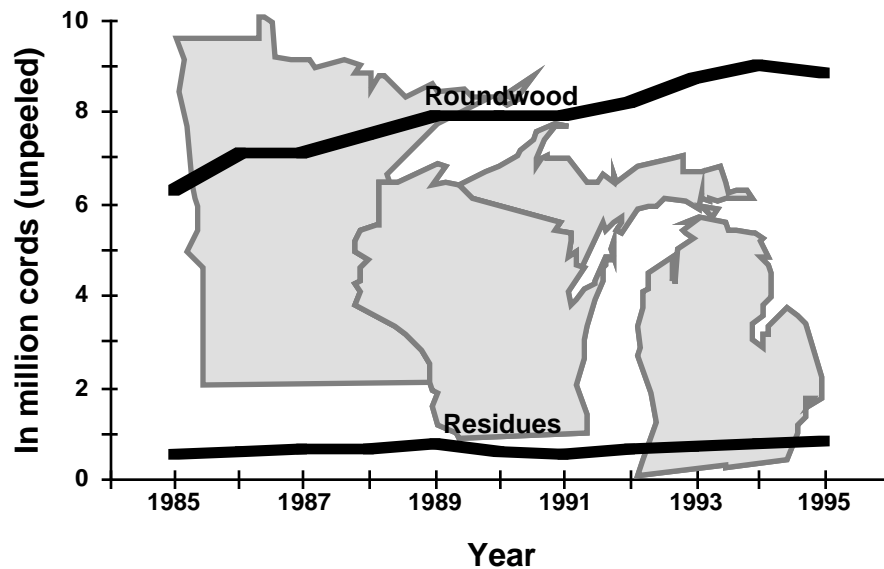


Figure 1.—Pulpwood production, Lake States, 1985-1995.

Pulpwood production² in the Lake States—Michigan, Minnesota, and Wisconsin—decreased to 9.6 million cords in 1995 from 9.7 million cords in 1994³. Wisconsin produced 3.5 million cords, Michigan produced 3.1 million cords, and Minnesota produced 3.0 million cords in 1995 (table 1). Ninety-two percent of the pulpwood produced came from roundwood (including chips from roundwood); the remainder came from mill residues such as slabs, edgings, veneer cores, and chips from these materials (fig. 1).

ROUNDWOOD

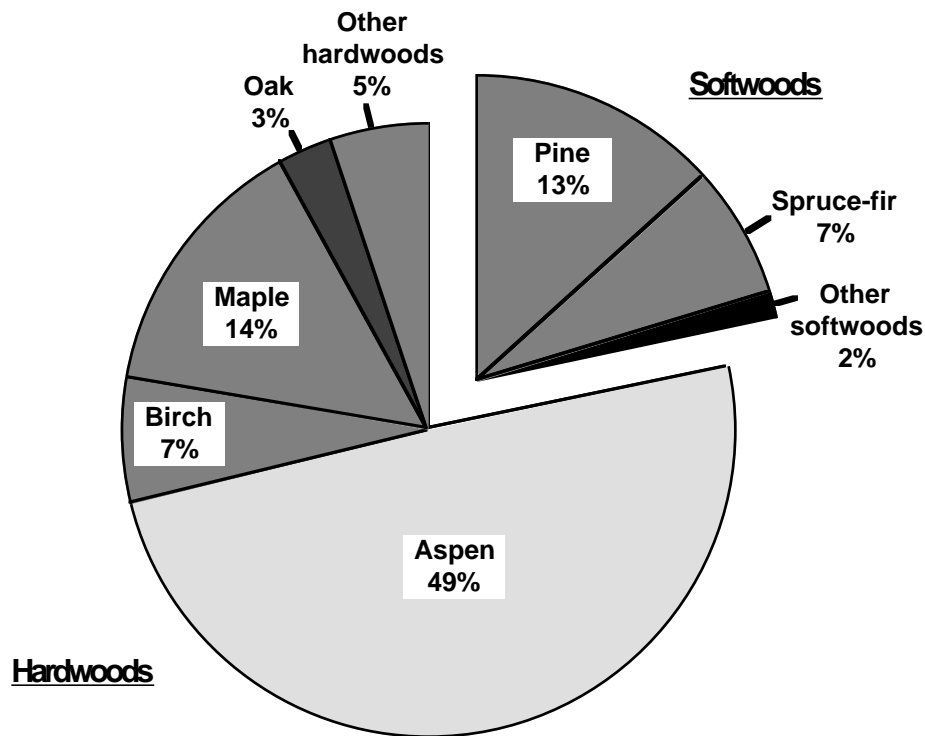


Figure 2.—Distribution of roundwood production by major species group, Lake States, 1995.

Roundwood production totaled 8.8 million cords; Michigan and Minnesota each produced 2.8 million cords and Wisconsin produced the remaining 3.1 million cords. Seventy-eight percent of the harvested species were hardwoods. Aspen accounted for 49 percent of the total production (4.3 million cords). The other major species groups were maple (1.2 million cords), pine (1.2 million cords), spruce-fir (0.6 million cords), and birch (0.6 million cords) (fig. 2).

Counties harvesting more than 150 thousand cords each were Houghton, Iron, and Marquette in Michigan; Beltrami, Cass, Itasca, Koochiching, and St. Louis in Minnesota; and Bayfield, Douglas, Iron, Sawyer, and Vilas in Wisconsin. These 13 counties contributed 38 percent of the roundwood pulpwod produced in the Lake States in 1995.

In 1995, whole tree chips (WTC) supplied 564 thousand cords or 6 percent of the roundwood production, a 17-percent decrease from 1994. Michigan was the major WTC producer with 340 thousand cords, followed by Wisconsin with 134 thousand cords, and Minnesota with 90 thousand cords.

MILL RESIDUES

Pulpwood production from mill residues amounted to 804 thousand cords in 1995, a 6-percent increase over 1994. Mill residue production increased by 15 percent in Michigan and by 6 percent in Wisconsin, but decreased by 5 percent in Minnesota. Production from softwood and hardwood residues by State was:
